2011 Boy Scout Summer Camp – July 10-16, 2011
Ransburg Scout Reservation, Bloomington, Indiana

Troop 69 will be attending Boy Scout Summer Camp at the Ransburg Scout Reservation from Sunday, July 10, to Saturday, July 16, 2011. The Ransburg Scout Reservation is the premier Scout camp in the Midwest. The camp stands alone at the top because of its diverse programs; state of the art facilities; excellent, committed, quality camp staff; and outstanding service to Scouts and Adult Leaders. The 624-acre camp, nestled in the Hoosier National Forest, is located on beautiful Lake Monroe, near Bloomington, Indiana.

The 2011 Early-Bird Summer Camp fee for Troop 69 Scouts is \$220.00. This fee covers the basic camp fee (\$205.00), our Wednesday night in-camp dinner (\$8.00), and a Troop 69 Summer Camp T-shirt (\$7.00), which is worn each morning for breakfast.

Please note that other fees may exist at camp for merit badges and/or other activities chosen individually by your Scout. The extra fees will be discussed at a later time.

There are two payment options for the camp fee. You can pay \$220.00 in a lump sum payment on or before February 28, 2011, or you can make three scheduled payments over the next couple of months.

If you choose the payment plan, \$75.00 must be paid on or before February 28, 2011; \$75.00 must be paid on or before March 28, 2011; and a final payment of \$70.00 must be paid on or before April 25, 2011. All fees for Summer Camp must be paid in full by April 25th – NO EXCEPTIONS.

I will start collecting fees at the Troop meeting on Monday, February 7, 2011, and will continue to do so through the April deadline. If I am not able to attend a meeting, I will designate another adult to collect the fees during my absence.
